**Cross-border provision of public services for Wales** Aug 14 2022 Working practices between the UK and Welsh Assembly governments in relation to cross-border policies appear much improved since the Committee's earlier reports on this subject. But a number of outstanding issues remain in transport, health and further and higher education. On transport the Committee welcomes the planned electrification of the Great Western Main Line. However, the Department for Transport appears to have washed its hands of any strategic responsibility for cross-border roads. The A483 is the clearest example of a road vital for travel within Wales but which is not important to the English region in which it is located, and as a result loses out on funding. The Committee stresses the need for comparative data on which to build solid research comparing NHS performance in the devolved nations. More needs to be done to raise public awareness of the differences in services people can expect to receive on both sides of the border. Transparency of information is vital. Research proposals in the UK Government's Higher Ambitions strategy for higher education make no reference to nations other than England, despite the UK-wide research remit of the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills. The Committee calls for details about how research funding proposals apply to all four nations.

*Native Listening* Jan 19 2023 An argument that the way we listen to speech is shaped by our experience with our native language. She describes infant speech perception, the consequences of language-specific specialization for listening to other languages, the flexibility and adaptability of listening (to our native languages), and how language-specificity and universality fit together in our language processing system. Drawing on her four decades of work as a psycholinguist, Cutler documents the recent growth in our knowledge about how spoken-word recognition works and the role of language structure in this process. Her book is a significant contribution to a vibrant and rapidly developing field.

Peer Social Support, Self-efficacy Beliefs and Social Anxiety in Adolescence Mar 29 2021 Peer relationships become increasingly important during adolescence. Adolescents spend more time with their peers and begin to select their own friend groups on the basis of intimacy and support. As such, it is clear that social support from peers is critically important. Although it is evident that peer sources of social support are critical during this time period, often times, the unique contributions of different peer sources, such as classmates and close friends, is not investigated. Despite this, the literature suggests that different peer sources of support are associated with different social-emotional outcomes, demonstrating a gap in the literature. One outcome commonly associated with social support is social anxiety. Social anxiety is described as the intense feelings of fear, worry and apprehension that occur within the context of social relationships. Many of the cognitive behavioral models of social anxiety emphasize the role of self-efficacy in the development and maintenance of social anxiety. The current study aimed to extend the literature examining these three constructs by examining the associations among social support, self-efficacy and social anxiety in adolescence. Specifically, the current study examined two competing mediation models. The first model investigated whether self-efficacy perceptions may explain the associations between social support from peer sources and social anxiety. The second alternative model investigated whether social support from peer sources may explain the associations between self-efficacy beliefs and social anxiety. The results indicated support for both models, with significant gender differences emerging. For girls, both models were supported. For boys, social support from classmates mediated the association between social self-efficacy and social anxiety.

**An Investigation Into the Relationship of Life Events, Self-concept, Social Support, and Stress** Jul 01 2021 This research investigated the relationship of self-concept, social support, and life events with stress. One-hundred-eighty-six volunteers, 110 women and 76 men, completed the Tennessee Self-Concept Scale, the inventory of Socially Supportive Behaviors, the social Readjustment Rating Scale, and the SCL-90-R. Regression analyses revealed that self-concept contributed the greatest amount of variance to stress scores, followed by life events, and then social support. All were statistically significant, and contributed a total of 35% of the variance in stress scores. Analyses of variance found no interaction among variables at low levels of life events. At both high and low levels of life events, neither self-concept nor social support alone combined with life events to form a statistically significant interaction. At the level of high life events, a statistically significant interaction of gender, social support, life events, and self-concept was found. Further analysis resulted in a statistically significant interaction of social support and self-concept with women experiencing high life events. Main effects for social support were not found. Evidence for the buffering hypothesis of social support at high levels of life events was found. The major conclusions of the researcher were: strong self-concept plays a more important part in the low stress levels than either life

vents or social support; evidence for the buffering effect of social support was seen at high levels of life events; social support buffered the effects of life events among women with low self-concept.
