**Experimental Studies to Establish Scaling Laws for Modeling Cavitation Damage**

**Intensity** Sep 27 2020 An experimental facility called the 'rotating foil apparatus' was designed and built to study cavitation erosion in an actual but controllable hydrodynamic system. Test results from this apparatus have confirmed the time dependence of cavitation intensity and also

indicated the relationship between erosion intensity ( $I_{sub e}$ ) and cavitation parameter ( $\sigma$ ) for an NACA 16-021 foil section at 181 ft/sec. A family of the  $I_{sub e}$  versus  $\sigma$  curves is sought for several velocities so that the true relation between  $I_{sub e}$  and velocity can be established thus providing a clue of the pressure which causes the bubbles to collapse. Additional testing is planned to determine the relationship between Reynold's number ( $Re$ ) and erosion intensity ( $I_{sub e}$ ) for several values of cavitation parameter ( $\sigma$ ).
